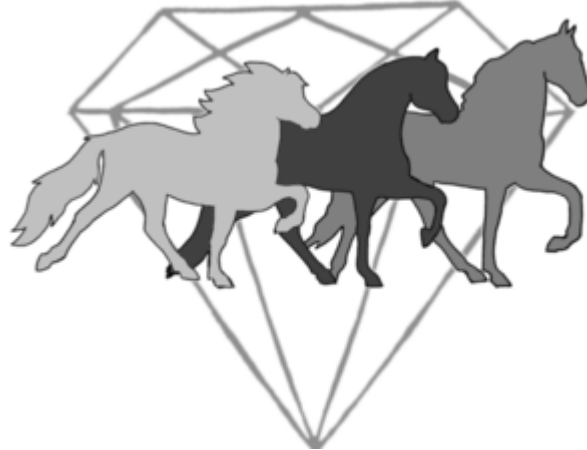

## **ENTRY DEADLINE: Aug 18, 2011**

Entries *WITH PAYMENT* must be received by this date to avoid post entry fees. Post Entry \$20/horse.

### **Entry Fee – Unlimited Classes –**

**\$180 per horse for members of either club, covers both shows**

**(\$200 per horse non-members)**

Entry fee for horses **only** shown in Halter

\$50 per horse for members

\$70 per horse non members

Show entry and release forms must be signed. All entries into designated Peruvian, Icelandic, Tennessee Walking Horse, & Missouri Fox Trotter classes to be accompanied by a photocopy of the horse's registration certificate, or in the case of a "registration pending", a copy of the application for registration.

Horses qualifying for Champions at this show are required to show in the Championship classes (or have veterinary excuse) or they will forfeit their prizes from the qualifying class. Horses that qualify for Championship classes at this show will **not** be charged extra fees to show in those classes.

**Stall and Tack Room Fees: \$70 per horse or tack stall, from Friday 10:00AM until Monday at 10:00 AM, additional nights stalling/tack can be arranged at an extra \$20 per stall per night. \$85 per stall for sale horses not entered in the show. Special Stall Rate for halter horses occupying stall one night or day and leaving Friday - \$35.00.**

### **POST ENTRIES**

**Post entries will be allowed and will be accepted by the show secretary up to 15 minutes before start of session. If you are unsure of entering a class, enter the class and then if you decide not to enter, scratch the class at the gate.** For a horse not entered in the show with fee paid by Aug 18, 2010, there will be a post entry fee of **\$20.00 per horse** for unlimited classes, in addition to other entry fees. If you are entering, please send by email to [entry@snowfiresams.com](mailto:entry@snowfiresams.com) with Diamond Classic in the subject line, or enter online at [www.saskperuvians.net](http://www.saskperuvians.net) or [entry.snowfiresams.com](http://entry.snowfiresams.com). An invoice will be sent out after entry is received. Please help our show secretary who does this important job - Enter in advance if you possibly can. Thank you!

Anyone entering Friday must pay (or leave a signed, blank cheque) and leave signed release forms with the secretary at the show office before going into a class. The Show Office Trailer will be open Friday afternoon to accept entries. **No exceptions** - give yourself extra time!

### **MAILING AND ONLINE ENTRIES AND SPONSORSHIPS**

Payment will be accepted by Cheque, Money Order, Cash or Paypal/Credit Card. Cheques and Money orders should be made payable to SPHC and mailed to **Deb Yip** 1624 – 16A Street SE Calgary, AB T2G 3S7. Emailing of entries to [entry@snowfiresams.com](mailto:entry@snowfiresams.com) with Diamond Classic in the subject line, or entering online at [www.saskperuvians.net](http://www.saskperuvians.net) or [entry.snowfiresams.com](http://entry.snowfiresams.com) is helpful to the show secretary, Deb. **HOWEVER**, be aware that payment must be received by deadline to avoid late entry fees. Once payment is made, if a horse cannot come, another may be substituted at no extra charge. All refunds except stall fees require a valid veterinary certificate of illness or injury.

### **APPROVAL AND POINTS**

The Saskatchewan Regional Championship Show is Sponsored by the Saskatchewan Peruvian Horse Club (SPHC) and the Kneehill Regional Championship Show is sponsored by Peruvian Enthusiasts and Recreational Riders Unlimited (PERRU). Each Peruvian show and its classes are approved by the Peruvian Horse Association of Canada for **DOUBLE** points and eligible entries will receive **DOUBLE** points per show, toward annual and lifetime PHAC awards. Eligible entries in Walking Horse classes will receive points toward Alberta Walking Horse Association annual awards. The show is sanctioned by FOSH (Friends of the Sound Horse), points will be awarded accordingly and the **seven FOSH principles apply**. Versatility Division is for all gaited horses regardless of lineage or breed and is not a championship division. **Top Three** Combined High Point Versatility horses will win **PRIZE MONEY**. This is a drug-free show and may be tested.

**Please note and advise your trainers: No mistreatment of horses will be tolerated, including excessive use of whip and spur in the ring or anywhere on the premises.**

## **REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS**

**All breeds, crosses and types of gaited horses are eligible to compete in the versatility division of this show.** No registration certificate is required for entry into FOSH versatility classes **ONLY** but registration numbers will be recorded if a certificate is presented. A photocopy of registration for all horses entered in **breed-specific** classes **MUST** be provided before horse is shown. Owner **MUST** match registration or an authorization signed by the registered owner presented.

**Peruvian horses** registered or pending with the Peruvian Horse Association of Canada are eligible to be shown in the PHAC approved classes. Peruvian horses owned or leased by residents of Canada must be registered or pending with the PHAC. Peruvian horses owned by residents of other countries are eligible to be shown provided they are registered or pending with NAPHA. Owners in arrears with PHAC, SPHC or PERRU will not be allowed to show until arrears are cleared.

**Walking Horses** must be registered with either the CLRC or TWHBA to enter TWH designated classes.

**Icelandic horses** must be registered with the Icelandic Horse Federation (CLRC) to enter Icelandic designated classes.

**Missouri Fox Trotters** must be registered with the MFTHBA to enter MFT designated classes.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Show organizers are most desirous of fair treatment for all exhibitors and ask for the cooperation of all in helping to make this show a successful and enjoyable event. Show participants are responsible for knowledge of, and subject to the rules and regulations as follows:

### **For Exhibitors of Peruvian horses:**

The Peruvian show will be run according to the PHAC Book of Show Rules. The most current version is found on the website [www.phac.ca](http://www.phac.ca). In any case where this Premium List may seem to conflict with these rules, the PHAC Book of Show Rules shall take precedence. In addition, the Seven FOSH principles apply. See [www.FOSH.info](http://www.FOSH.info) for rule book.

**PLEASE NOTE:** *Helmets are recommended for all Juniors 18 & under, However Juniors 12 and under MUST wear approved equestrian helmets as per PHAC rules and may ride with Peruvian leather stirrups. Wooden stirrups must be used with Peruvian saddles unless rider is twelve years old and under or has a physical reason and has requested an exception from the show committee. Peruvian work tack is acceptable for shows, as long as the headgear is braided not flat leather.*

Peruvian Horses in the bit entering Champion, Best Gait or Champion of Champions classes must complete 4 classes prior to their first champion class or do the Prueba Sunday morning. Please note that some qualifying classes may be on Sunday morning so plan accordingly.

### **For Exhibitors of Tennessee Walking Horses:**

Rules will be as per the FOSH Rule Book 2009, which is available at [www.FOSH.info](http://www.FOSH.info).

### **For Exhibitors of Icelandic Horses:**

Rules will be as per the international rulebook for Icelandic horse events (FIPO).

### **For Exhibitors of Missouri Fox Trotter Horses:**

Rules will be as per the FOSH Rule Book 2009, which is available at [www.FOSH.info](http://www.FOSH.info).

### **For all Exhibitors in the Versatility Classes:**

Classes in the VERSATILITY DIVISION will be run according to the FOSH 2010 Rule Book and by descriptions and procedures in this Premium List. Tack and attire for the Versatility Division should be suitable for showing and appropriately matched; no mixing of tack with regards to saddle and bridle (i.e. when western saddle is used, a western bridle should be used as well, except as noted in FOSH rules.)

### **SUBSTITUTION OF JUDGES AND OTHER OFFICIALS**

In the event that the judge (or other official designated herein) is unable to perform his/her duties due to circumstances beyond his/her control or for any other reason, the Show committee reserves the right to substitute another approved judge (or other official) in his/her place.

### **JUDGE'S AUTHORITY**

In the Versatility Classes, the judge will make every attempt to judge according to the descriptions in the Premium List. Percentages are intended as a guideline.

The Judge shall have the authority to place any horse in whatever position in a class that he thinks the merit of the horse justifies. The Judge shall award prizes in order starting with first and may not vacate places. This applies whether there are one or more entries in a class. If there are more horses of merit in a class than there are prizes offered in that class, the Judge has the right to award honorable mentions. The Judge may make favorable comments over the public address system about the horses shown before him, but shall make no negative comments.

### **RESPONSIBILITY**

All entries are accepted with the understanding that SPHC, PERRU, PHAC, Alberta Walking Horse Association, FOSH, members of the show committee, and Prairieland Ag Centre, will not be held responsible for any loss, personal damage or injury to horses exhibited, or for any article of any kind or nature that in any way may be lost or destroyed or in any way damaged. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Management but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person or animal or damage to any property while on the grounds by any horse owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify the management against all claims or damages of any kind or nature, including attorney fees and court costs, that may arise out of any injury occasioned by any horse owned or exhibited by him or arising from any cause whatever including the negligence of himself or any other person in charge of any such horse. The SPHC is a member organization of the Saskatchewan Horse Federation and expects and encourages members to take advantage of the SHF or AEF membership and liability coverage. PERRU is a member organization of the Alberta Equestrian Federation and expects and encourages members to take advantage of the AEF membership and liability coverage.

### **STABLING FACILITIES**

**Every horse must have a stall**, except suckling foals stabled with their dam in a box stall. Stalls will include first bedding of shavings, and additional shavings will be available for purchase on the grounds. Stalls will be available for use on Friday, Sept. 2 at 8:00 AM and must be vacated by Monday, September 5, 10:00 am. Horses may not be removed from premises during show unless express permission is granted from the show steward, show manager or show committee. Owner with horses coming in prior to Friday must reserve extra night(s) in advance. **Halter Horses that are only competing Friday may leave the show after the conclusion of Halter classes & championships Friday with prior approval from the show steward, show manager or show committee, & Stall rate will be \$35 per stall for halter horses in stalls one night or day and leaving on Friday.**

There is an indoor Wash Rack in the Barn that will accommodate many horses. All exhibitors are advised to bring feed, snaps, buckets, hay nets, wheelbarrows and other items necessary for the care of their horses.

The stabling barn is in the same building as the arena. There are plenty of box stalls, including stalls for tack rooms. Please note that the barn will be divided, as the race horses from Marquis Downs Race Track may reside on the same grounds, however they will not be in the arenas or have access to the half of the barn or the aisle ways designated for our show.

**WARM UP RING** - Outdoor warm up is permitted in the outside Arena. In case of inclement weather, a limited covered warm-up is available in between stalls and arena. Stalls, limited warm-up and arena are all under one roof.

**PARKING** – Cars may park near the arena. Trailers used for camping must park in designated areas. Please note that the camping area with power hookups is at the far end of the parking lot, anyone choosing to camp in the trailer parking area across from the arena will still be charged camping fees and should note that there are **NO** power hookups.

### **GATE RULE**

There is a PA system in the main barn and classes will be called to the warm-up arena and as much as practical, to the trailer area, and to the barns. However, it will be exhibitors' responsibility to know what class is in the ring. The 3 minute gate rule will be enforced. Check in with the gate steward well in advance of your class. An additional 5 minute tack change can be requested IN ADVANCE. If you have classes back to back with different horses, you or a helper can bring tack and/or horses to the saddling area near the arena ahead of time so you will have time to make the switch.

**NO RIDING IN THE BARN AISLES &**

**ALL DOGS ARE TO BE KEPT IN THE CAMPING AREAS, AND ON LEASH.**

**NO DOGS IN THE BARN OR ARENA.**

To reduce congestion and for safety, please tack and un-tack your horses in their stalls.

### **HOSPITALITY**

Coffee and continental breakfast will be provided every morning.

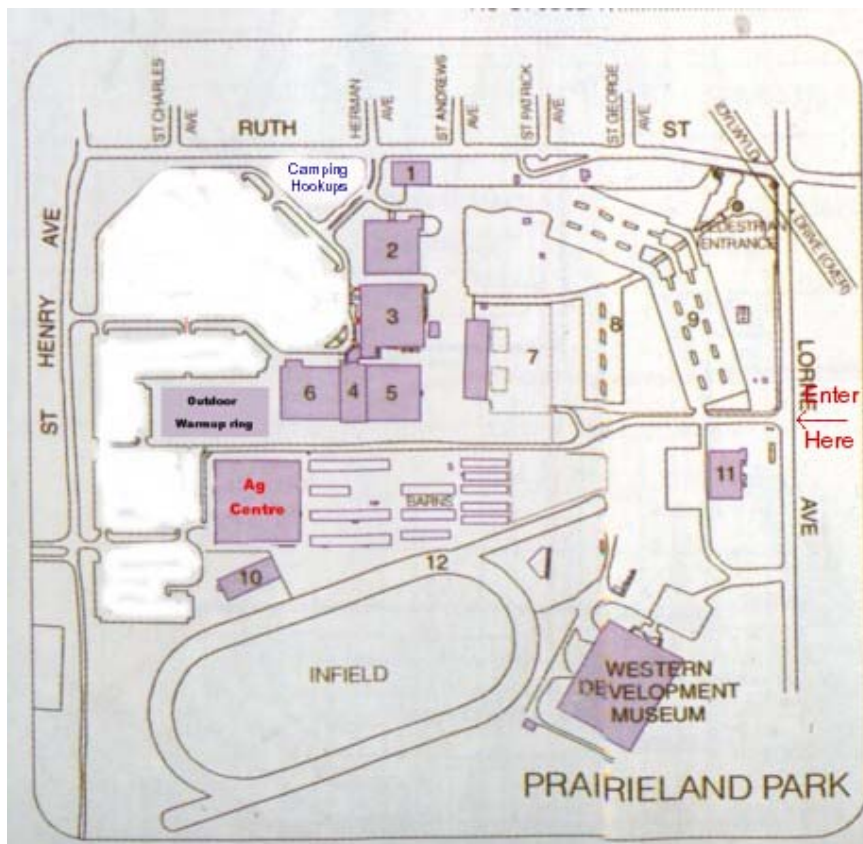

## CAMPING –

1. There are a limited number of water and electric hookups at \$15 / night, first come, first reserved. In the hook-up area, Trailers must be parked straight in to camping space with no crosswise parking.
  2. Camping is available beyond the warm-up area, a short distance from the barns, also at \$15 per unit per night with **NO** power. Cross-wise parking **MAY** be allowed at discretion of facility management.
- Dogs must be on leashes when outside of vehicles and are **not** allowed in the barns.  
Showers are available free for those who pay for camping on the grounds with or without power (In building nearby).

## HIGH POINT AND RESERVE HIGH POINT VERSATILITY HORSE

### Prize money for EACH SHOW:

High Point Versatility wins \$125.00,  
Reserve High Point wins \$80.00;  
3<sup>rd</sup> place is awarded \$45.00.

Classes qualifying for this award are open to **ANY GAITED HORSE**. If you have an unusual gaited breed or a “cool crossbred”, here is your chance to shine! Points will be awarded 1 - 6 in each class (1 for participation, 6 for 1st place.) The entry with the highest number of points placings in specified classes from **each show** will be High Point, second highest will be Reserve High Point. **ONLY THE TOP 6 CLASSES FOR EACH HORSE WILL BE COUNTED**. In the event of a tie, the decision will be made based first on placing in the OGB Equitation Two-Gait, secondly by placing in OGB Pole Bending.

Horses at this show if shown in bit, must be in bit throughout show, if shown in bozal, hackamore, sidepull, must show in that headgear throughout show. In classes where FOSH rules allow bitless and bitted to be mixed, that will be allowed. Peruvian classes will specify In Bit or In Bozal, or both. **Note: “Bozal” refers to a Peruvian Bozal, Western Bosal, Bitless Bridle, Western Sidepull, or Hackamore.**

Attire for rider in Open Gaited Breed Versatility can be any outfit suitable for showing, that includes equestrian style boots, and hat and belt matching in style to the tack used. Blue jeans are discouraged but not prohibited.

**Please note that for the OGB Trail Obstacle Class, OGB Barrel Racing, OGB Flag Race, & OGB Pole Bending a single rider is allowed to present more than one horse but not more than three.**

### **VERSATILITY CLASS DESCRIPTIONS –**

**Open Gaited Breed Trail Obstacle** - Obstacle class judged on negotiating 6 – 10 items such as flat bridge, gate, poles, back-throughs, etc. On third refusal must go on to next obstacle. Each exhibitor will be timed. There is a four minute limit. The judge will be provided with a point grid and a qualified assistant judge may judge some obstacles to keep the class moving. Trail course will be posted in office. (FOSH rules) A rider may exhibit more than one horse in this class, but not more than three horses. Other entries will be put in between so that the rider has time to change horses.

#### **Open Gaited Breed Western/Traditional Pleasure 2 Gait -**

**See FOSH rules section Chapter 10 for Country Pleasure. (Peruvian or other non-english / Plantation saddle allowed if traditional to the breed. )**

#### **Open Gaited Breed English / Plantation Pleasure 2 Gait –**

**See FOSH rules section Chapter 10 for Country Pleasure.**

**Open Gaited Breed Water Glass 2 Gait** – Exhibitors will perform maneuvers such as walk, gait, extended gait, stop, circles and backing while holding glass of water in one hand. Class is to demonstrate how smooth the horse is and exhibitor must keep fingers below the rim of the glass. Exhibitor may hold glass out to side or in front of himself but will not be asked to hold glass above head or below knee.

**Open Gaited Breed Pole Bending in Gait** – Horses will negotiate a standard pole bending course and will be timed. Any horse breaking gait for more than one stride will be disqualified. A rider may exhibit multiple horses in this class but no more than three. Other entries will be put in between so that the rider has time to change horses.

**Open Gaited Breed Barrel Racing in Gait** – Horses will negotiate a standard barrel pattern and will be timed. Any horse breaking gait for more than one stride will be disqualified. A rider may exhibit multiple horses in this class but no more than three. Other entries will be put in between so that the rider has time to change horses.

**Open Gaited Breed Flag Race in Gait** – There will be four flag poles placed in barrels in the arena and a fifth empty Barrel Closest to the arena entrance. Riders must get the flags and put them in the empty barrel one at a time, until all four flags are in what was the empty barrel. This is a timed event, any horse breaking gait for more than one stride will be disqualified. A rider may exhibit multiple horses in this class but no more than three. Other entries will be put in between so that the rider has time to change horses.

**Open Gaited Breed Equitation** – Judged solely on Equitation of the rider appropriate to the breed and tack presented.

**Open Gaited Breed Pairs Performance 2 Gait** - To be judged 60% on performance as a team and 40% on matching or complimentary appearance and attire. Any gear allowed provided that a saddle and bridle is used on each horse. Attire is at discretion of riders but should be modest and riders must wear shoes or boots. Maneuvers will be called at the judge's discretion, including but not limited to circles, stops, backing, figure eights and reverses.

#### **Open Gaited Breed Beginning Natural Horsemanship**

To demonstrate the partnership between horse and rider. Horses must be ridden with a soft rope halter or a soft rope around the neck. Saddles are optional and any type may be used but the rider **must** wear a helmet. Horses enter the ring one by one and complete a pattern that includes obstacles. Horse will first negotiate obstacles in hand or at liberty at handler's direction, then the rider will mount and repeat the course mounted. (Mounting block may be used). Horse must stand ready and alert to his rider. Placing will reflect emphasis on horse and rider showing overall harmony and partnership.

#### **Open Gaited Breed Bareback \$5 Bill Ride**

To demonstrate skill of the rider and smoothness of the horse riders will ride bareback with a \$5 Bill held between their leg and their horse. When a rider loses their Bill or falls from their horse they are eliminated and must return to the centre of the arena to await outcome of the class. The call judge may ask for changes in gait or direction, and ask for various other maneuvers until only one horse/rider combo remains. Riders will provide their own \$5 bill and as the riders are eliminated their bills will be added to a pot that will be awarded to the winner of the class.

#### **Open Gaited Breed Obstacle Reining**

To demonstrate the skill of the rider and fluidity of the horse, this class contains elements of a normal reining pattern, circles, figure 8, backup, etc, done around obstacles. Will be judged on each maneuver/obstacle. Each exhibitor will be timed. There is a four minute limit. Pattern will be posted in office. (FOSH rules) A rider may exhibit more than one horse in this class, but not more than three horses. Other entries will be put in between so that the rider has time to change horses.

### **MEETING WITH THE JUDGES, Main Arena**

The judges will be introduced to exhibitors at a meeting in the arena, Friday at **3:30pm** prior to the halter classes. **Note:** *If any rider is physically challenged and has special needs for equipment or instructions, please note on the entry form and we will pre-clear with the show committee and judge.*

#### Note regarding PHAC Junior and Novice Points:

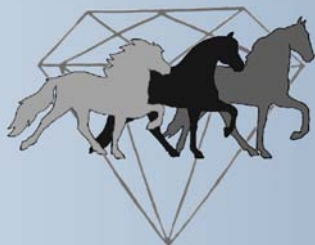

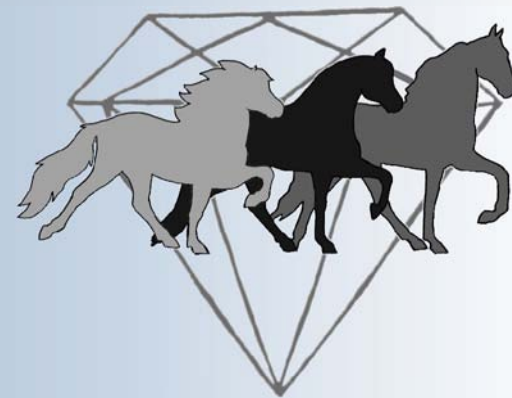
