These points go towards the Medallion d'Oro, Medallion de Plata and High Point Performance Horse Awards. Champions & Champion of Champions from this show qualify for their respective Championship Classes at the NAPHA National Show. Persons delinquent in payment to a NAPHA approved show will not be permitted to enter this show This show is also approved by the PHAC and qualified entries will receive points toward annual and lifetime awards. All participants must present registration papers or proof of registration pending for every horse entered in this show, as well as proof of placings for direct entry into Ch of Ch classes.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Entry Fees

The unlimited fee is intended to act as an incentive to encourage people to enter more classes than they might otherwise do at a class by class rate. It applies to Juniors and adults. It also eases the burden on the office staff by rewarding those who pay one time in advance. If you have entered at the single class rate and wish to upgrade to the flat fee rate you may do so by paying the unlimited fee, however previously entered classes will not be credited toward that fee.

We do not require payment to be submitted with your entry form. It is hoped that this will encourage you to enter as many horses as you think might attend. Your payment at the show will reflect only the horses you bring. No vet excuse is required, however, a one time late fee of \$20/horse will be charged for horses not entered by the Deadline for mailing entries, 7/22.

Stall Fees ~ \$90 (tack \$55)

Stalls are from Thursday night through Sunday afternoon, including bedding. Extra days are \$25. (Tack stalls no bedding.) **A free tack stall will be given to those bringing 5 or more horses, or travelling more than 500 miles from their home.** Exhibitors should contact Cathy Brown (253.333.1803 elcondado@aol.com) in advance for your stall requirements. Each horse entered must be assigned a separate stall, except mares with suckling foals. Horses must be placed in stalls as assigned. No showing out of trailers. Stalls containing horses may not be locked! No dogs in barns or arena! Please contact barn manager in advance.

Post Entries

Entries should not be mailed after July 22nd. Entries should then be faxed, emailed or brought to the show, and will incur a one time \$20 late fee per horse. Exhibitors wishing to add classes must do so a minimum of three classes in advance.

RV & Camping

RV parking & camping are available at \$20/ day without hookup, \$25/day with power & water. Reserve spaces on the entry form, and notify Cathy Brown when reserving stalls.

Display & Vendor Space / Evergreen Sponsorship

There is a charge of \$100 for anyone selling anything on the Show Grounds Friday - Sunday. Contact Tereasa Loyd, 360-333-1803 tereasa.loyd@gmail.com for reservations. **Evergreen Sponsorship** - Ranches or vendors may place a banner in the arena for \$100 for the duration of the show and place ranch info on the hospitality table.

Membership & Registration Requirements

Horses registered with the NAPHA, AAOBPPH, or PHAC are eligible to enter this show. Horses under one year of age must be eligible for registration and registration must be applied for but must be listed as unnamed . **Registration papers for each horse must accompany entries. Proof of eligibility to enter directly into Ch of Ch classes must also be included.** The NPHC reserves the right to decline any entry. Anyone not in good standing with NAPHA may not enter this show. Exhibitors are not required to be members of the above organizations. Multiple registered horses should supply all papers.

Prueba Funcional

NAPHA Rules forbid requiring completion of a Prueba Funcional for entry into Championship classes, therefore this show will not require one.

Refunds ~ Please Note!

Entry fees are not due until arrival at the show. Charges will be based on horses actually brought to the show and no vet excuse is required. If a horse is present on the show grounds and deemed unable to perform, a veterinary statement must be presented to the Show Secretary prior to the end of the show in order to obtain a refund. No refund after one class has been entered. Purse class fees will not be refunded unless the horse is removed from the remainder of the show with a veterinary statement.

Class Changes & Substitutions

If a horse entered is unable to perform, another horse may be substituted. A horse may also be moved from one class to another. In each instance the gate **must be notified three classes in advance** but no fee will be charged. Changing riders or handlers is also free, but the same notice must be given.

Conduct

Each exhibitor will display their horse in the most natural way possible and maintain their horse in suitable manner. **No smoking is permitted in or around the barn areas. No dogs are allowed in the barns or arena. This rule is strictly enforced by showgrounds officials. In addition, no alcohol will be permitted in the barns or arena.** Only participants in the class, the Judge and Ring Steward or their assistants will be permitted to enter the arena. Attendants are not permitted in the arena unless summoned by the Judge or when specified in this Premium. Anyone entering the arena as an attendant must be dressed in white shirt and pants. Under no circumstances may the Judge be approached during classes. Any person or horse may be barred from entering the ring if not suitably presented. No one may make any remark or commit acts during the show that are considered offensive or made with intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging. Any exhibitor may be barred from the show for this offense. Acts of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of an owner, rider, handler or member of the family participating in the show may disqualify them or their horses from adjudication. The management may remove any of the aforementioned persons from the show without being liable for compensation or damages. The NPHC reserves the right to decline any entry.

Ribbons

Rosette ribbons are awarded to fifth place in all classes except those for Juniors, which will be awarded to eighth place. First place finishers will receive engraved awards and Championship classes will be awarded neck ribbons and trophies.

Juniors

A Junior has not attained the age of 18 on January 1st of 2011. No Junior under 15 on January 1st of 2011 may show a stallion. No ungelded males over 12 months may be shown in any class designated for Juniors. **Retrancas are prohibited in Junior classes. Baticola is required, floron is optional and helmets are encouraged. Juniors under 13 may use leather covered Peruvian Stirrups (tapaderos) and must wear helmets.** Classes will be divided into 12 and under & 13 and over. Age groups may be combined but judged separately. **Juniors may not compete in Novicio Division Classes.**

Foals

No horses are to be allowed to run free, including foals, regardless of age.

Sales Presentation

There will be a presentation of horses for sale after classes 15, & 48 The enclosed form must be completed for all horses presented and a \$40 fee paid for each animal **not entered in classes at the show.** See form for further restrictions.

RULES FOR CLASSES

Bozal Classes - 5, 7, 9, 39, 51 (see page 9 for percentages)

The same horse shall not be shown in both bit & bozal at the same show. Only horses 3 & 4 years old are permitted to show in bozal (see page 11 - Shoes.) First & Second place qualifies for Best Bozal (67). Bozal horses are allowed in classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 17, 23, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 31, 32, 34, 36, 39, 42, 45, 47, 51, 53, 54, 55, 67. No jackets, ponchos, pells or spurs.

Geldings Purse (\$300 added to entry fees) - 10

Horses in bit, only. Entry fee is \$50. Prize money to be divided as follows: 1st - 50%, 2nd - 30%, 3rd - 20%. Judged as breeding Class.

Reining - 11, 12, 52,

Open to horses 4+ in bit, amateur and professional. Poncho to be folded on saddle. No gamarilla, bozalillo or maquinaria. Spurs are mandatory except for Juniors, who may not use them. Juniors may enter a bozal horse in junior class.

Trainer Challenge ~ \$200 purse ~ 24

This class is to showcase the trainers skill in producing a well rounded horse. Each trainer may ride 1 horse in the bit for the class. The horse must have been in training for at least 3 months in the past 2 years. No cross training between trainers. The class will be judged as a group on the rail as breeding, on gait and on maneuvers. Maneuvers will be individual work. Each entry will have 2 minutes of freestyle time. Required maneuvers will be a figure 8, figure 6, caracole, stop, stand and back. Regular class fee. No gamarilla or bosalio allowed.

Pairs Class ~ 26

Two horses perform together, music optional, no costumes. Judged on creativity of maneuvers, riding skill, ability to perform together and how horses compliment one another. 2 minute limit, bit or bozal, shoes ok.

Ladies/Gentlemen to Ride, 48, 50

Open to all genders, in bit. Judged as a performance class. Winners qualify for Performance Championship classes appropriate to their gender.

Trail Classes - 29, 30, 31, 32 (only 30 counts towards versatility)

Open to horses 4+ in bit, amateur and professional. No ponchos although jackets are allowed. Juniors may enter bozal horses. Class 32, shoes and bozal over 4 yrs ok. Three refusals allowed before the rider must proceed to the next obstacle. Trail classes held in the outdoor arena Saturday morning, 8:30 to noon. Register with the office for a time that is convenient for you. Dan McCallister is the trail judge.

Gait Classes - 33, 35, 37

Open to horses 4+ in bit, amateur and professional. 1st & 2nd place qualify for Best Gaited Horse of Show (68). 100% gait.

Bozal Gait - 39

1st & 2nd place qualifies for Best Bozal (67). 100% gait.

Amateur Performance - 38, 40, 41 (see page 9 for percentages)

The rider must be an amateur with a declaration on file. This class qualifies for the Champion & Reserve Amateur Performance Horse (58).

Drugs & Artificial Appliances

The use of performance altering drugs is banned. This includes, but is not limited to stimulants, depressants, tranquilizers, local anesthetics, anti-inflammatories (including "bute") and drugs which might mask the presence of forbidden substances. The only exceptions are topical antibiotics and hormonal treatment for estrus cycle control. **Warning:** the use of any drugs within 72 hours of the show may produce measurable levels in urine or blood and result in a violation. Horses entered in this show are subject to a physical, saliva, urine or blood test. Refusal to submit to any of these constitutes an admission of guilt. Exhibitors agree to be bound by the rules and penalties mandated by the NAPHA, including, but not limited to, forfeiting prizes, places and points.

RULES FOR CLASSES

Crystal Class - 27

Open to all sexes 12 years or over (any horse born before 2000) This class is intended to recognize the mature horse. It is judged as a Breeding class, but is non-qualifying. A crystal trophy, will be awarded. Shoes & bozal are permitted.

NPHC Amateur Owner Purse (\$200 added purse) - 28

Entry fee is \$50. Rider must be an NPHC member, registered as the owner of the horse (or immediate family members), as well as an amateur with amateur declaration on file. Prize money to be divided as follows: 1st - 50%, 2nd - 30%, 3rd - 20%. Judged as a breeding class - non qualifying.

Champagne Calcutta (no entry fee) - 23

Open, bit or bozal, any age. Shoes are permitted. Peruvian bit only. Spectators will bid, auction style, on the rider they believe will finish with the most champagne. Winning bidder gets 40% of the purse, rider gets 20% and club gets 40%.

Novice Horse ~ Trail 32

This class is for horses which have not won more than three blue ribbons in any trail class. This class does not qualify for Versatility High Point.

Get of Sire / Produce of Dam - 53 / 54

Get consists of 3 or more get, produce consists of two or more produce, bit or bozal, breeding, with emphasis on uniformity. Only one entry per sire or dam. To be made with permission of sire/dam owner.

Outstanding Junior Sportsman Award - 65

Not a judged award, voted on by Juniors. The Sportsmanship award is presented to the junior showing the greatest sportsmanship during the show, as determined by all juniors. It does not count towards the Junior High Point Award.

Junior High Point and Reserve - 66

Junior High Point & Reserve is an award for the junior receiving the most points from classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 11, 12, 29, 31, 34, 36, 45, 47 only and is calculated as follows: 1st-10 pts, 2nd-8 pts, 3rd-5 pts, 4th-3 pts, 5th-1 pt. Juniors participating in regular classes will not receive extra points. High Point classes divided 12 & under, 13 & over. Age divisions may be combined but judged separately. Juniors may not enter Novicio Division Classes.

Championship Classes - 57 - 64, 67, 68

See page 9 for percentages. Winners of 1st & 2nd place in all classes qualifying for classes 57 to 64, 67 & 68. All Breeding & Luxury Division classes are Peruvian Tack classes, although a pella is not required.

Champion of Champions Classes 69 - 75

Open to current and past Champions from the NPHC Regional Show and PPHRNA, NAPHA, and PHAC National Shows. Past Champions may not compete in qualifying classes for their division if they wish to enter directly, but may enter other division classes. Those entering directly as past Champions and not entered in any other classes at this show must pay an **entry fee of \$55 for members and \$90 for non members**. Those entering directly as past Champions and also entered unlimited in another division, or non-qualifying classes are covered by their unlimited entry fee. **Proof of past Championships should accompany entry form**. All Breeding and Luxury Division classes are Peruvian Tack classes - whites and ponchos or jackets required. NAPHA Rules do not require horses to complete the Prueba in order to enter the Championships, therefore this show will not require one.

Versatility High Point - 20, 21, 22, 30, 33, 35, 37, 43, 46, 49, 52

Participants must register at the beginning of the Show and pay a \$10 entry fee. **No classes will count points for participants unless they register at the office and pay \$10 before class 20**. Points are as follows: 1st - 5 pts, 2nd - 4 pts, 3rd - 3 pts, 4th - 2 pts, 5th - 1 pt. Winner may ride in the closing Barrida.

Tack & Attire

All Breeding/Luxury qualifying and Championship classes are Peruvian Tack Classes, requiring a traditional Peruvian saddle that is clean and functionally sound. Class 52 requires spurs and the poncho folded on the saddle or a jacket. No gamarilla, bosalillo, maquinaria or any device which affects the bit or mouth is allowed. In all other classes tack other than Peruvian **must** be consistent over the entire horse, with the exception of the bit. All horses in this show **must** use the Peruvian bit or bozal, regardless of tack. **English saddle may not be used with bozal**. Rider's attire to be white shirt and pants, Peruvian hat, scarf and appropriate colour boots and poncho or jacket (in bozal no poncho, spurs or jacket allowed) for Peruvian tack, or clothing appropriate for the tack used (see NAPHA rules.) For ladies, a white split riding skirt may be substituted for white pants. With western tack, lariat and hobbles are not mandatory. Equestrian hard hats are allowed in all classes. No spurs in bareback

Performance Division ~ 20, 21, 22, 43, 46, 49

Horses must be finished in bit. This division is open to professionals and amateurs alike, unless specified as an "Amateur" class (38, 40, 41)

Breeding Division ~ 13, 14, 15, 16, 18, 19, 44

Horses must be finished in bit and at least 4 years of age. Open to professionals & amateurs. Ungelded males must be registered as Breeding Stallions. No spayed mare may be shown as a Breeding Mare. All qualifying and Championship classes in this division will be Peruvian Tack classes.

Novicio Division - 6, 8, 17, 42

Participants need not own or lease their horse, but must use the same animal in all Novicio classes in order to qualify for the High Point Award. Open to all genders, bit or bozal (bozal, 3 - 4 years,) shoes ok. Rider cannot have won more than 3 first place ribbons in previous Regional Peruvian Shows. Points are as follows: 1st - 5 pts, 2nd - 4 pts, 3rd - 3 pts, 4th - 2 pts, 5th - 1 pt.. Winner may ride in closing Barrida.

Percentages for Breeding/Luxury Division

Bozal - Conformation 35% Condition 5% Brio & Temperament 20% Gait 40%

Bit - Conformation 27% Condition 5% Brio 27% Gait & Collection 41%

Percentages for Performance Division

Condition 20%, Performance, Brio, Suitability & Manners 60%, Gait 20%.

Stallions

For the purposes of showing, stallions 4 years and older will be required to have 2 descended testicles, the exception being those registered as breeding stallions with one descended testicle for which veterinary certification has been obtained showing that the missing testicle was lost due to non-hereditary causes such as injury or illness, and must be registered as Breeding Stallions to compete in the Breeding Division. No Junior under the age of 15 as of January 1st, 2011 may show a stallion in any class. No ungelded males over 12 months may be shown in a class designated for Juniors only. Horses are considered 1 year old on January 1st of the year following their birth.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Cross Entries

Horses are permitted to enter both Breeding and Performance Division classes. Horses may not show in both bit and bozal in the same show.

Judges' Authority

The Judges shall have the authority to place a horse in whatever position they believe the merit of the horse justifies. They must, however, award places according to merit starting with 1st and continuing in order. This applies whether there is one entry or many. If there are more horses of merit in a class than prizes, the Judges have the right to award any number of Honorable Mentions. The Judges' decisions as to the placing of horses in a class is final. Under no circumstances will exhibitors be allowed to discuss their standings with the Judges.

Judges' Option

The Judges may ask to ride any horse entered under saddle, except for Performance Division classes. **Exhibitors may elect to not have the Judge ride their horse, but should notify the Ring Steward upon entering the class.** The Judges will not be responsible for any injury which the horse may sustain during this time. Likewise, the owner will not be responsible for any injury which the Judges may suffer resulting from their riding a horse.

Interaction with the Judges

Please join us in extending a warm welcome to our Judge, Bonnie Gallegos. We would like to make her feel welcome at our show and encourage everyone to get to know her. We ask, however, that all exhibitors respect the Judges' professionalism and ethics and understand that this is of the utmost importance. We invite appropriate interaction with all show officials, and while it is not our intent to isolate the Judges at social functions, we must insist that any questions regarding particular horses, placings at the show, one's performance or anything pertaining to this show be directed to our Show Steward. There will be a chance to meet with and question Ms Gallegos Thursday evening at 8:00 pm

Call for Classes

Classes will be announced 3 classes in advance. Three minutes will be allowed after the first horse enters the ring. If a tack or attire change requires a gate hold, the Gate Steward, Bonnie McLoughlin, must be notified in advance. No one may enter the arena after the gate has closed.

Artificial Markings

Only clear grooming materials are allowed on the hide or hair except that white powder may be used on white markings. Clear grooming materials may be used on hooves, but black may not. Artificial mane or tail pieces are prohibited.

Substitution of Judge or Other Officials

The NPHC reserves the right to substitute another approved Judge or other official in place of those listed in this premium.

Responsibility

All entries are accepted with the understanding that the NPHC, NAPHA, and grounds and arena owners will not be held responsible for any loss, personal damage or injury to horses exhibited, or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or destroyed or in any way damaged. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Management but solely at the risk of the exhibitor who will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person or animal or damage to any property while on the grounds by any horse owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify the management against all claims or damages of any kind or nature, including attorney fees and court costs, that may arise out of an injury occasioned by any horse owned or exhibited by him or arising from any cause whatever including the negligence of any other person in charge of any such horse.

Health Requirements

Washington State Department of Agriculture requires horses entering the state to have a current Health Certificate and a negative Coggins Test within the previous 6 months. Horses coming from OR & ID staying less than 96 hours need no health certificates. Additionally, OR horses do not need Coggins.

Veterinarian

There will not be a veterinarian on the grounds during the show, but will be on call. She will be required to call to management's attention any horse which exhibits symptoms of a communicable disease or lameness. If, upon mandatory inspection, the horse is found to be contagious or considered a danger to other animals, it must be removed from the showgrounds or quarantined.

Additionally, the Novicio Division (6, 8, 17, 42) will allow shoes, but bozal is limited to horses 3 & 4 years of age. These classes will not receive points, except for Novicio Division High Point. Proper tack and attire is required, **including a Peruvian bit or bozal.**



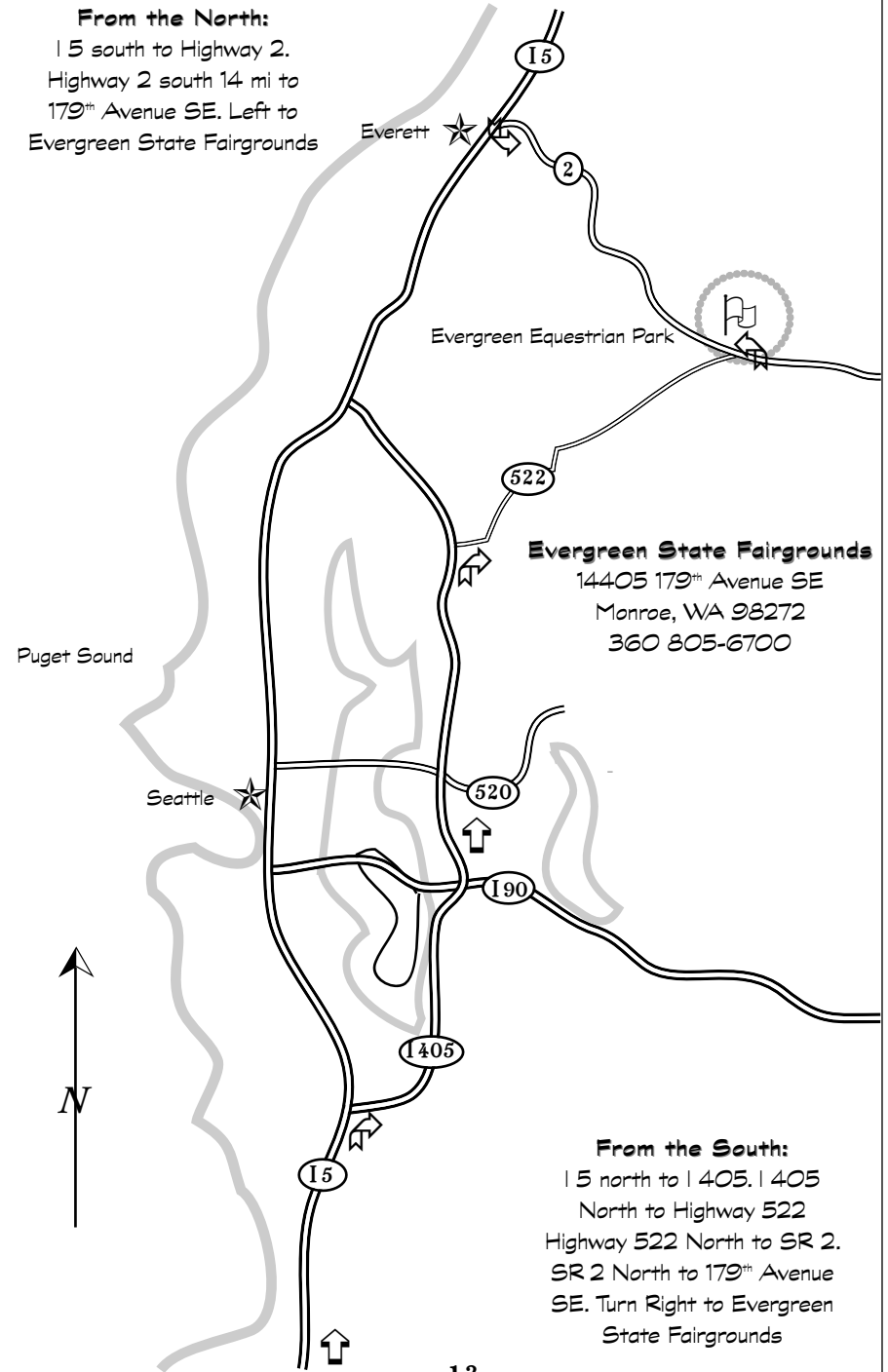
