

Pizarro's Pot A Graduation Award

This award is being introduced as an incentive to promote the young horse shown in bozal the first year and then in the bit the second year. It is open to Stallions, Mares and Geldings and is based on the total number of points won over two consecutive years. It is an incentive promoted by the PHCA only, and the points used will only come from competing at the same PHCA Regional show for 2 years in a row.

The qualifying classes will be Breeding/Luxury, Gait and Open Performance (bozal gender, bozal gait, bozal performance; breeding/luxury gender, gait gender, and open performance). Points won in the first year will be carried over to the following year and at the end of the second consecutive show the points from the two years will be tallied up and the horse with the most points will be declared the winner.

Horses entered into this incentive must be registered with the Peruvian Horse Association of Canada. If the horse is sold after the first year of competing, it is still eligible for the award if the new owner enters and pays the entries for the 2nd year. The points are for the horse only; not the horse/ rider combination or for the owners, and these points for this award are calculated separately from the PHAC High Points. They do not interfere with the PHAC members' High Point Awards.

Horses entered in this incentive will be judged as a class within a class in the perspective qualifying divisions. The points awarded will be as they are placed in a class. The points awarded in each division are as such as:

- 1st - 6 points
- 2nd- 5 points
- 3rd- 4 points
- 4th- 3 points
- 5th- 2 points
- 6th- 1 points

For example: If you are showing in Mares Bozal and there are 6 mares in

the class but you place 3rd and the horses that placed 1st and 2nd are not entered into this incentive program, you will be awarded 6 points for being the highest placing horse in the program, but if one or both of the horses that placed higher than you are entered into the incentive program, you will be awarded 2nd or 3rd place points. These points will then be carried over to the next year, added to the current year's points, and the horse with the highest number of points registered in the incentive program will win the Pizzaro's Pot.

In the event of a tie, the Open Performance class will be the tie-breaker. In the event of a second tie, the total number of Championships will be tallied.

The entry fee is \$75.00 for the first year and \$75.00 for the second year of competition. Photocopies of the registration papers and cheques are due by the annual PHCA Regional Show.

Pizzaro's Pot will be distributed as follows:

1st Place - 55% of the two year pot
2nd Place - 25% of the two year pot
PHCA - 20%.
